

Once downloaded, install the app and launch it by tapping the app icon on your home screen.


STEP 2: Login or Create Your Account

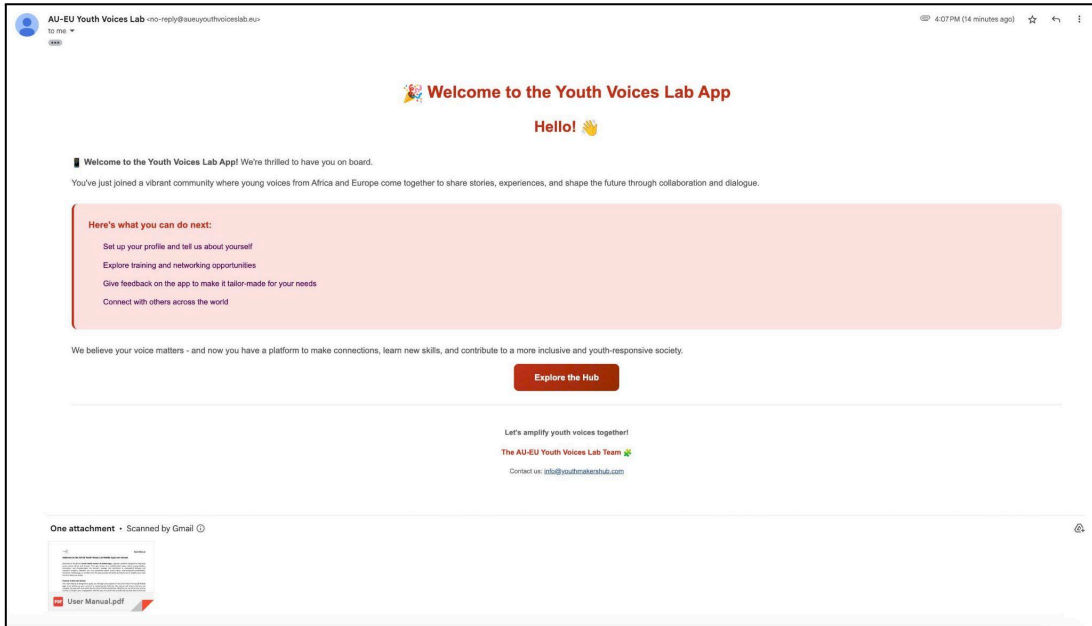

The screen will automatically change the "Complete your profile" screen to personalize your profile to enhance your experience.

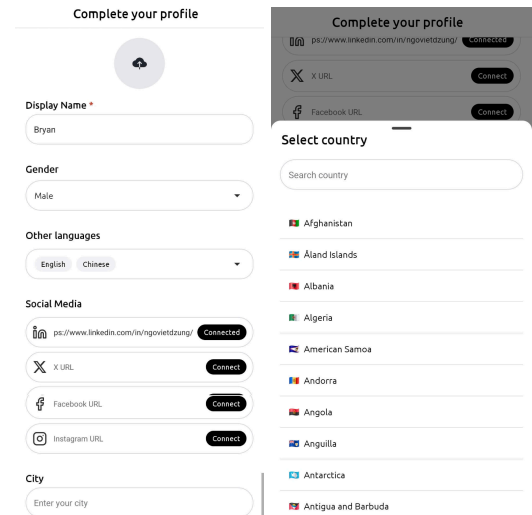
After filling out all fields, tap the "**Complete Profile**" button at the bottom of the screen to save your information.

 - Once you've made your selections, tap "Done" to confirm.

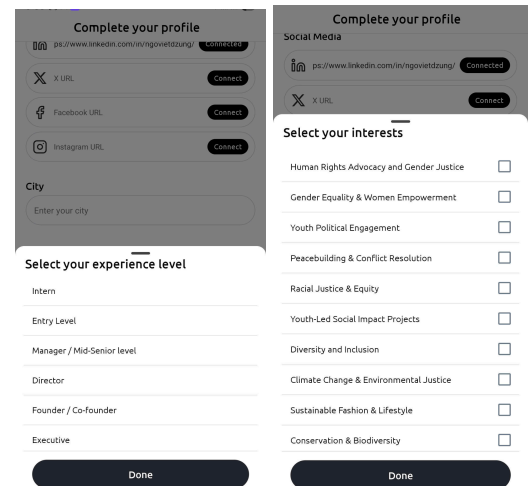

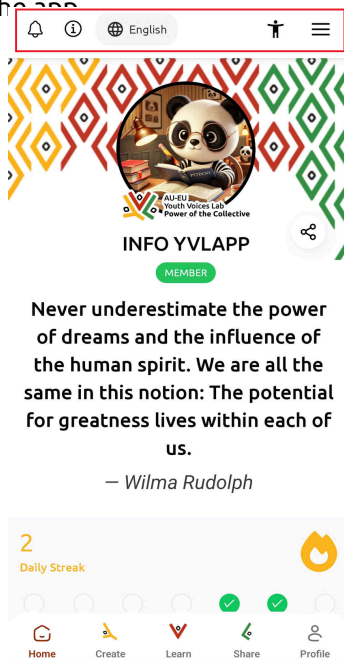


STEP 3: Explore the App Features

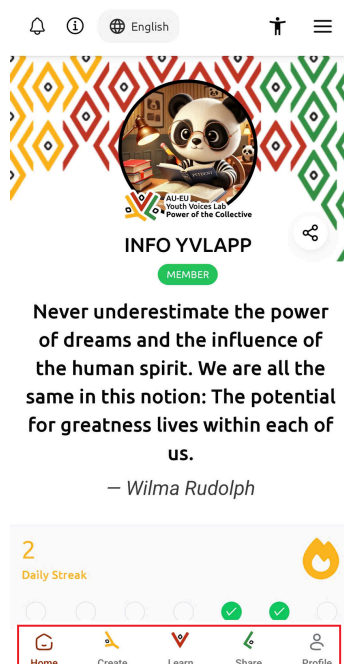
Once logged in, the first screen you'll encounter in the AU-EU Youth Voices Lab app is the **Home Section**, which acts as the central hub for navigating all features and content. This section is thoughtfully designed to inspire and guide users, offering a clean and intuitive interface. At the top of the screen, known as the **Heading (Top Bar)**, and the bottom of the screen, referred to as the **Footing (Bottom Navigating Bar)**, users will find key icons that support app customization, navigation, and accessibility. These icons play a crucial role in shaping the user's experience within the app.



A. Top Bar - Heading Icons

You'll find 5 icons at the top of the screen allow you to access key settings and functionalities:

-  **A1. Notifications** - View updates, alerts, and announcements in chronological order from the app.
-  **A2. About** - Offer insights into the AU-EU Youth Voices Lab program and a link to its official website.
-  **A3. Language** - Change the language of the app to suit your preference.
-  **A4. Accessibility** - Adjust accessibility settings to optimize the app for your needs, which are designed to support marginalized and vulnerable communities.
-  **A5. Menu** - Open the main menu for additional options, managing accounts, privacy settings, and app preferences.



B. Bottom Navigation Bar - Footing Icons

The bottom navigation bar contains the 5 main sections of the app, which are accessible via distinct icons, allowing you to explore and interact with its features.

B1. Home Section

The Home section serves as the central hub for users, offering access to personal progress, motivational content, ongoing courses, updates, and feedback opportunities. It is designed to keep users informed, inspired, and engaged with the app's core activities.

B2. Create Section

The Create section empowers users to shape the app experience by contributing feedback and engaging with youth-centered development initiatives. It includes two key features: Surveys and Feedback, providing users with opportunities to share their opinions, ideas, and experiences.

B3. Learn Section

The Learn section is the go-to space for accessing educational content, tracking progress, completing lessons, and earning certificates. It serves as a comprehensive hub for personal growth and skill development through

curated learning materials.

B4. Share Section

The Share section fosters community engagement, collaboration, and networking among users. It includes four main features: Opportunity Desk, Groups, Bookmarks, and Starred, all designed to connect users and promote meaningful interactions.

B5. Profile Section

The Profile section acts as a personal dashboard where users can view their information, track progress, and showcase achievements. It provides a detailed overview of the user's identity, learning journey, and performance metrics within the app.

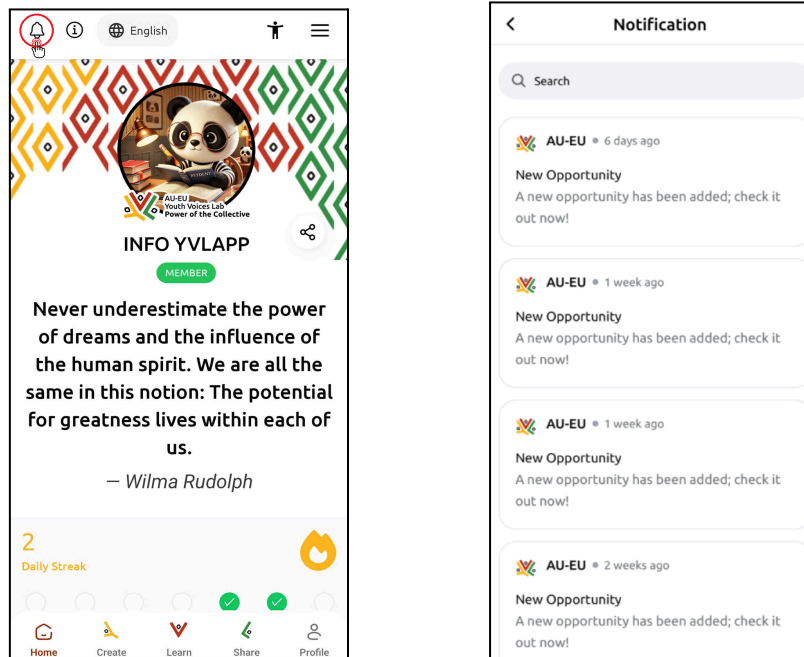


A. Top Bar - Heading Icons

A1. NOTIFICATIONS

The Notifications in the app acts as a centralized hub for keeping users informed about updates, opportunities, and activities tailored to their interests. Its primary purpose is to ensure users never miss important information, whether it pertains to surveys, courses, or new job opportunities.

Notifications are presented in a chronological order, with timestamps (e.g., "6 days ago," "1 week ago") clearly indicating when each update was posted. This structure helps users easily identify the most recent and relevant updates.



Key Features of the Notification Section

● Chronological Notifications

- Notifications are displayed in order of posting, starting with the most recent updates.
- Each notification includes a timestamp, such as "6 days ago" or "2 weeks ago," providing users with a clear understanding of when the information was shared.

● Search Bar

- A Search Bar is integrated into the Notification Section, enabling users to search for specific notifications or keywords.
- This feature is especially helpful for users who receive frequent notifications and need to locate a particular update quickly.
- Example: Users can search for terms like "New Opportunity" or "Survey" to filter relevant notifications.

● Action-Oriented Updates

Notifications are designed to prompt users to take action, such as:

- Enrolling in a new course: Notifications might say, "A new course has been published; start learning today!"
- Participating in surveys: Messages like, "Your feedback is requested—take the survey now!" help users engage with app features.
- Exploring job opportunities: Alerts such as, "A new opportunity has been added; check it out now!" encourage users to explore career-related updates.

Notification Settings

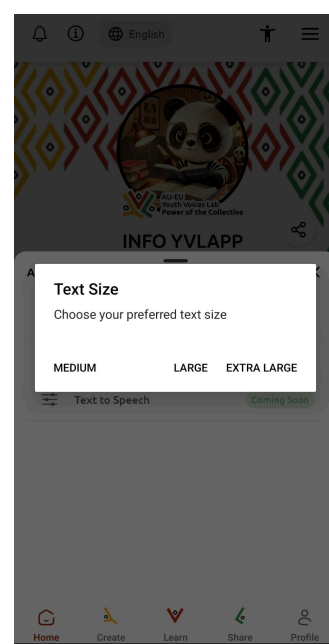
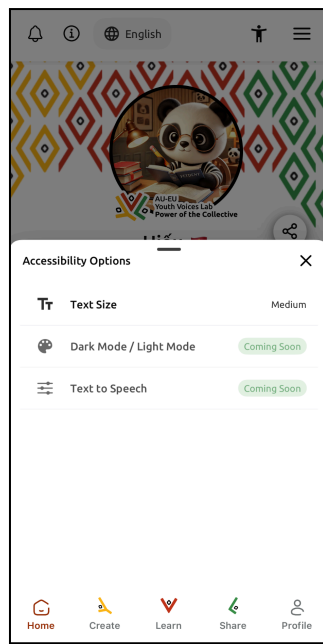
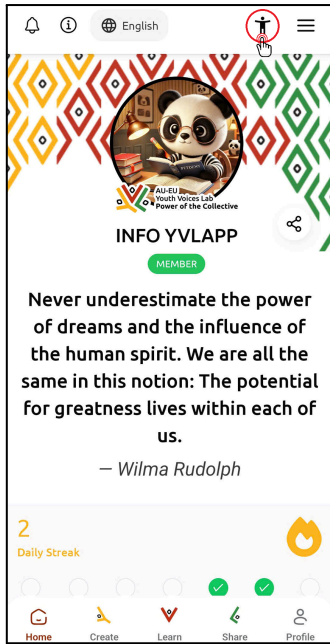
Future Expansion
